Length: 3 hours

Summary: Participants will learn how to scaffold 3 types of higher order thinking activities for their students.

Sessions: Schools can choose 3 one hour sessions from the following options or investigate one of the options in more depth.



Options: With each option, we examine why it involves higher order thinking plus participants experience a range of scaffolds which support students' learning and assessment.

- 1. Learning new concepts
- 2. Critical thinking
- 3. Problem solving
- 4. Creativity
- 5. Metacognition and reflection
